

CONDITIONS FOR USE OF CAMPSITE

AUSTRALIAN INTERNATIONAL AIRSHOW AVALON 2009



CAMPSITE DATES

- 1 Camping is only available from Friday 6 March to Monday 16 March 2009.
- 2 Notification of extended period of stay must be arranged with Camp Site Administration Office one day prior to original departure date.

ARRIVAL PROCEDURES

- 3 Campers must report to the Camp Site Administration to confirm or make a reservation.
- 4 Motor vehicles within the camping area will be restricted to "set up" and must be moved to the designated parking area within 30 minutes.

FACILITIES - AVAILABILITY & USE

- 5 There are no powered sites available.
- 6 Use of BBQs, gas lanterns and naked flame is not permitted.
- 7 Use of generators is not permitted.
- 8 Children under the age of 10 years must be accompanied to showers and toilets by a responsible adult.
- 9 Notification of equipment malfunction (e.g. showers, toilets etc.) should be made to Camp Site Administration Office for rectification.
- 10 Caravans, campervans etc. must provide buckets for the catchment of all liquid waste. Buckets are to be emptied at the toilet block facilities only.
- 11 Amplified music is not permitted.
- 12 Tent pegs are restricted to a maximum length of 250mm.

LOST OR FOUND PROPERTY

- 13 Articles lost or found should be reported to Camp Site Office.
- 14 There are no facilities available for the storage of personal property or valuables.

BEHAVIOUR

- 15 Behaviour must be of a suitable standard at all times. Disturbances or other inappropriate behaviour will be reported to camp site security or police for appropriate action.
- 16 Excessive noise after 11pm. will not be permitted.
- 17 Vandalism and/or damage to any property, buildings, vegetation will not be tolerated and offenders may be asked to leave the camping area.
- 18 The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry and may at their sole discretion require persons to leave the camping area. Inappropriate behaviour may result in all persons from the offending camp site being evicted.

GENERAL

- 19 All persons using the Camp Site are required at all times to comply with all instructions and directions issued by the organisers and its officials and/or authorised officers.
- 20 If any injury is sustained by any person while in the Camp Site, the incident must be reported to the Camp Site Administration Office as soon as practicable and preferably within 12 hours.
- 21 Untidy litter around the camp sites will not be permitted and use should be made of the rubbish containers provided.
- 22 In the event of an emergency, any directives given by Police, Country Fire Authority, Security or officers of the organisers must be observed.
- 23 All persons using the Camp Site do so at their own risk. The Organisers will not accept responsibility for negligent acts or omissions of any person other than the organisers or their officials, servants or agents.
